### VAXIN CEO TO JOIN PANEL OF EXPERTS IN DISCUSSION ON NATIONAL BIODEFENSE IMPERATIVES

**Gaithersburg, Maryland, Feb. 23, 2015** – On Tuesday the 24<sup>th</sup> of February at Texas A&M University, [The Blue Ribbon Study Panel on Biodefense](#) will host a Regional Roundtable on national biodefense imperatives. The theme of the day is *“The Human/Animal Interface for Biodefense: From Surveillance to Countermeasures”*. At the half-day event, [Vaxin](#) CEO Bill Enright will join a panel of experts to discuss *“Policy Recommendations for Enabling Flexible and Adaptable Development and Manufacturing”*.

The event takes place at the Annenberg Presidential Conference Center.

The discussion is part of an event series planned by The Blue Ribbon Study Panel on Biodefense. Established in late 2014, the Panel aims to identify and recommend changes to U.S. policy and law to strengthen national biodefense, while optimizing resource investments. Meetings will be held in Washington DC, and regional workshops in the spring of 2015. Panel co-chairs include Former Senator Joe Lieberman and former Governor Tom Ridge. Additional members include former Secretary of Health and Human Services Donna Shalala, former Senator Tom Daschle, former Representative Jim Greenwood, and the Honorable Kenneth Wainstein.
